



College and Career Ready Virginia

WHAT IS IT?

The College and Career Ready Virginia Program (CCRV) allows all public high school students the opportunity to earn college credit through a 5 course (Passport) or 10 course (Uniform Certificate of General Studies -UCGS) pathway, at no cost to the student or their families. These courses are provided by a student's home high school with credentialed high school faculty or online by college faculty.

Each public high school partners with a local community college to provide a specific set of courses to meet requirements for the UCGS. While every course that is eligible for the Passport or UCGS will not be available at each high school, courses outside of the prescribed pathway may be taken at cost at the community college. Courses in the approved pathway taken outside of the high school at the community college will still count toward completion of the Passport or UCGS.

- Save money by earning one year of college credit at no cost
- Complete postsecondary credentials faster
