WHAT IS THE IMPACT ON MY DEGREE OF WORK I HAVE ALREADY COMPLETED?

- Associate Transfer Degree Completion: Associate Degree will cover all General Education requirements except the (R-research) and (M-senior seminar). Students will still need to complete these two requirements at MBU.
- Dual Enrollment Completion of Associate Degree in HS: : Associate Degree will cover all General Education requirements except the (R-research) and (M-senior seminar). Students will still need to complete these two requirements at MBU.
- Credit for Prior Learning: MBU does accept AP (score of 4 or 5), CLEP (minimum score of 50), IB (score of 5,6, or 7) and some ACE credits for transfer.
- Catalog Year: Students adopt the catalog year of their transfer or may choose subsequent years after matriculation.
