#### **Guaranteed Admission Agreement**

By meeting the following criteria, students who complete the prescribed curriculum and meet the criteria below are guaranteed admission into Radford University.

- Earn a transferable associate degree
- Earn a minimum of 2.8 cumulative GPA
- Good standing at the current institution
