VCCS and Shenandoah University Guaranteed Admissions Agreement

By meeting the following criteria, you are guaranteed admission to SU undergraduate programs (acceptance to Shenandoah Conservatory and School of Nursing is competitive; additional application requirements will be necessary)

- Completion of Applicable Associate Degrees: AA, AS, AA&S
- Meet minimum GPA requirement: 2.5 or higher
- Earn grades of "C-" or higher in all community college courses.
- Applicants will need to submit an official transcript showing they have met the above requirements to the SU Office of Admissions

- Credit for Prior Learning: You can earn credit for your results on AP, IB, and CLEP exams
- Catalog Year: Catalog year determined by first semester of attendance at
- Joint Service Transcripts: Shenandoah is a military friendly institution. SU awards credit based
 on ACE recommendations for students with a military background. Military personnel must
 provide their official transcript from their particular branch of the service by using the Joint
 Services Transcript request system to earn credit
